New Private Mental Health Unit at Baringa Private Hospital Bindarray Clinic



Dr Doug Andrews - Director of Psychiatry Bindarray Clinic, On-site, consulting 5 days per week

Dr Doug Andrews started his career in the Coffs Harbour area in 1986, in general practice continuing this until 1999. After a stint working in the United Arab Emirates he redirected his career into psychiatry. He undertook speciality training at Coffs Harbour hospital and the Prince of Wales Hospital in Sydney, completing a fellowship in psychiatry in 2005. In his final year of training he undertook a research fellowship in early psychosis. Befitting regional practice he has broad interests.

Most recently he has been the Clinical Director for the Mid North Coast Area Health Service Mental Health Service. With a strong desire to move back into full time clinical practice he is leaving the public mental health system to take up the position as Director of Psychiatry at the Bindarray Clinic at Baringa Hospital and to establish a private practice there. He is an adult general psychiatrist and will see patients across the adult range to old age.
